## Notes.

- 1. This form contains a Single/Regular Donation/Gift Aid Declaration. Please complete the relevant parts and send it to the Secretary of the Royal Navy Club.
- 2. All Regular donations can be made by Standing Order or by the Direct Debit system from a Bank or Building Society in the United Kingdom. For Direct Debit mandates, The Royal Navy Club is authorised to collect only the fixed amount specified on your form. The Royal Navy Club guarantees that it will make no other collections. Should it do so in error, a full and immediate refund will be made. To allow for both The Royal Navy Club and your Bank to process, this form must be received by the Secretary at least two months before the first payment is due.
- 3. You may cancel this declaration at any time by writing to the Secretary of the Royal Navy Club.
- 4. In order to qualify for Gift Aid, you must have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that you donate to will reclaim on your gifts for that tax year.
